

Accreditation Requirements for Fire Fighting Training Providers

Requirement	Description	Authority
QCTO / SETA Accreditation	The training provider must be accredited by the relevant SETA or QCTO to offer the unit standard: • US 12484 – Perform basic firefighting (NQF Level 2, 4 Credits)	HWSETA / QCTO
SAQA-Registered Unit Standard	Training must align with the SAQA unit standard 12484 , ensuring nationally recognized content and assessment criteria.	SAQA
Registered Assessors & Moderators	Facilitators must be registered Assessors and Moderators with the relevant SETA for Unit Standard 12484.	HWSETA
Approved Training Material & Equipment	Provider must use approved training material and have practical fire-fighting equipment (extinguishers, simulator, PPE, etc.) for demonstrations and assessments.	HWSETA / QCTO
Training Site Compliance	Facilities must meet safety standards for live fire training (safe area, extinguishers, ventilation, supervision).	DEL / Fire Authority
Quality Management System (QMS)	Provider must maintain a SETA/QCTO-compliant QMS for training delivery, learner assessments, and record keeping.	HWSETA / QCTO
