| <b>Accreditation with QCTO/SETA</b>           | Providers must be <b>accredited by the relevant SETA</b> (usually <b>HWSETA – Health and Welfare Sector Education and Training Authority</b> ) or directly by the <b>QCTO</b> .                                                                                                                          | HWSETA / QCTO                       |
